WHEREAS the State Legislature is not in session and the Governor is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

Now, Therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution, the Governor is pleased to promulgate the following Ordinance:-

 This Ordinance may be called the Uttar Pradesh Commission for Backward Classes (Amendment) Ordinance, 2007.

Short title

2. In section 3 of the Uttar Pradesh State Commission for Backward Classes Act, 1996, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act, for sub-section (3) the following subsection shall be substituted, namely:—

Amendment of section 3 of president's Act no. 1 1996

"(3) The Commission shall consist of a Chairman, two Vice Chairman and seventeen other Member's nominated by the State Government from amongst persons of eminence, ability and integrity:

Provided that sixteen members including the Chairman shall be from amongst the backward classes."

3. In section 4 of the Principal Act,-

Amendment of section 4

- (a) for sub-section (1) the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:
- "(1) The Chairman, Vice-Chairman or every other member shall hold office for a term of one year from the date he assumes office:

Provided that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman or other member shall hold office as such during the pleasure of the State Government.

- (b) sub-section (3) shall be omitted.
- (c) After sub-section (5) the following sub-section shall be inserted, namely:-
  - "(6) (a) The Chairman shall be hairing the status of a Minister of the State.
    - (b) The 'Vice-Chairman shall be hairing the status of the Deputy-Minister of the State;
